



Six Local Minimum Standards for Anti-Social Behaviour

Minimum standards will cover a commitment to -

1. Reduce perceptions of Anti-Social Behaviour (ASB) year on year
2. Take reported cases of ASB seriously; recording, investigating and keeping victims informed of action taken
3. Provide regular information to residents on what action is being taken to tackle ASB
4. Offer support and practical help to victims of ASB
5. Ensure an effective link between neighbourhood policing and neighbourhood management
6. Provide residents with a right of complaint to Crime and Disorder Reduction Partnerships if effective action is not taken by local agencies through existing channels
